Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Meet your fellow traveling companions for transfer to the local airport in time to check-in for your overnight flight. Dinner and breakfast will be served inflight.

Day 2: Engelberg, Switzerland - Tour Begins

Upon arrival into Zurich, you will be transferred to Engelberg, a mountain-side resort nestled at the foot of Mt. Titlis. Relax in this beautiful village as you stroll the streets that are surrounded by white snowcapped peaks. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. *(D)*

Day 3: Engelberg - Bern - Engelberg

This morning you travel to the capital of Switzerland, Bern.

Explore delightful Bern on a panoramic sightseeing tour featuring the Bundeshaus (the Swiss Parliament), the famous Bear Pit, the Rose Gardens, and the gothic cathedral, which dominates the Old Town skyline. Tonight, enjoy a traditional Swiss cheese fondue dinner in one of Bern's local restaurants with the group. *(B, D)*

Day 4: Engelberg - Lucerne - Engelberg

Today you travel to Lucerne, the "Swiss Paradise on the Lake." Enjoy a leisurely-paced Altstadt (Old Town) walking tour exploring the hidden treasures of the city. In addition to its natural charm and tranquility, Lucerne has more than 800 years of history. **Explore such medieval treasures as the covered Chapel Bridge (1833); the famous Water Tower which has served as a prison, watchtower and treasury; the Renaissance-style Town Hall; the baroque Jesuit Church; and the Lion Monument, carved from natural rock to commemorate the heroic Swiss Guard.** The rest of the day is free to relax or take in a quiet meal at one of the popular local restaurants. *(B)*

Day 5: Engelberg - Innsbruck, Austria

Travel the picturesque highways of Switzerland to the Austrian border and the striking Olympic city of Innsbruck, the "Capital of the Tyrol." **A local guide leads a panoramic Innsbruck city tour highlighting the popular thoroughfare, Maria Theresienstrasse; the Hofburg, now a museum, but once the seat of Habsburg princes; and the "Golden Roof," all set against the imposing backdrop of the lovely Austrian Alps.** This evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner featuring local specialties. *(B, D)*

Day 6: Innsbruck - Salzburg - Innsbruck

Travel through the picturesque Austrian countryside to Salzburg, a city filled with beautiful gardens and wondrous architecture. Upon arrival, enjoy a leisurely-paced walking tour featuring Mirabell Gardens (seen in the "Sound of Music"), the quaint Getreidegasse (site of Mozart's birthplace), and many other highlights of this beautiful city. The afternoon is at leisure to explore and enjoy Salzburg's fabulous sights. **The day concludes with a delightful dinner in the historic city center at the centuries-old St. Peter's Restaurant, Austria's oldest, which may have hosted both Charlemagne and Columbus.** *(B, D)*

Day 7: Innsbruck

Today is at leisure for you to enjoy this beautiful city. You may choose to stroll through the old town and shop at many of the city's outstanding stores or perhaps venture into one of the city's many interesting museums. Or, you may just relax and breathe in the fresh mountain air while enjoying a beverage in the many cafés that truly make Innsbruck the charming city that it is. *(B)*

Day 8: Innsbruck - Bavaria, Germany -

Oberammergau

Fairy tales come to life today with a picture stop at Bavaria's most famous castle, Neuschwanstein. Next, visit Wies Church, proclaimed a World Heritage site, before proceeding to Oberammergau. Upon arrival, enjoy a brief orientation tour of this quaint, picturesque village. *(B, D)*

Day 9: Oberammergau - Passion Play

The morning is yours to enjoy at leisure. **This afternoon, witness the performance of the Passion Play with our Class A reserved seating.** The original performance dates back to 1634. During the Thirty Year War, the village of Oberammergau was spared the Black Plague and for this reason, the villagers vowed that every ten years they would give a play to honor the life of Christ. The performers are native Oberammergauers. Their long hair and beards are natural as they start to grow it a year or more in advance, and their costumes are made by local villagers. During the break of the performance, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner celebrating the end of a memorable trip. *(B, L, D)*

Day 10: Return to US

Transfers as a group are provided after breakfast for return flights to the US from Munich. Upon arrival, transfers are available complimentary back to our centrally located parking in Baltimore. *(B)*
