### Day 1 • Arrive in Billings, Montana Fly to Billings, Montana.

### Day 2 • Transfer to Cody • Visit Little Bighorn battlefield • Shell Falls

Transfer to Cody, Wyoming. Along the way, stop to visit the infamous battlefield of Little Bighorn, as well as Shell Falls, a waterfall situated in the Bighorn National Forest.

### Day 3 • Cody • Visit Buffalo Bill Center of the West • Heart Mountain

This morning, tour the Buffalo Bill Center of the West, widely regarded as one of America's finest Western museums. The center advances knowledge about the American West through acquiring, exhibiting, and interpreting collections of artifacts and preserving their physical and contextual integrity. Then, gaze upon Heart Mountain before returning to your hotel.

#### Day 4 • Transfer to Yellowstone

### Day 5 • West Yellowstone • Explore Yellowstone National Park

National Park, America's first national park
and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and home
to more geysers and hot springs than the
rest of the world combined. See the park's
numerous geothermal features such as hot
pools, fumaroles (smoke vents), and geysers,
including Old Faithful. And keep your eyes
open for some of the park's famous wildlife,
including grizzly bear, elk, fox, wolf, and
bison as you explore this true wilderness, 99
percent of which remains undeveloped.

## Day 6 • Transfer to Jackson Hole, Wyoming

This morning, depart for Jackson Hole, Wyoming. The first permanent settlers arrived in Jackson Hole in 1881, establishing it as a cattle-ranching center. The skiing industry took off in the 1930s, and Jackson Hole remains a winter sports mecca to this day. In the summer, this year-round resort offers hiking, river rafting, camping, and other outdoor activities.

#### Day 7 • Jackson Hole • Snake River float

Depart this morning for Snake River, where you'll enjoy an included raft tour. Gently wind your way through the waters of the Snake River corridor, granting you a unique look at the unspoiled wilderness and unique wildlife of Grand Teton National Park, keeping an eye out for elk, moose, falcons, eagles, and more. Dinner is included at a local restaurant tonight.

### Day 8 • Transfer to Salt Lake City • Visit Bear Lake


Depart for Salt Lake City, with a stop along the way at scenic Bear Lake, situated on the border of Utah and Idaho.
