


Figure 6 – Legislation Page

A search for legislation, by number, will redirect users to the legislation's page, as shown in Figure 6 below. Here you will find a **Summary** of the legislation including (Synopsis, Fiscal Analysis, etc...), any legislative **Documents** associated with the legislation including (Bill text for 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reader, analysis documents, amendments, vote, etc...), and the **History** of the legislation as it proceeds through the legislative process

**Note:** Users will find an additional bill query field, as shown in Figure 6 below, embedded on the resulting legislation page. This provides users with the ability to continue searching for legislation quickly without having to return to the Home page.

A **Broad Subject** search will generate a sortable table of related bills on the subject.

After locating a piece of legislation, user can click the *Tracking Tool* shot the **Utility Bar** to add the legislation to an existing tracking list or lists. Users must be signed in to take advantage of this feature. Please see note below.

The tracking system also allows users to maintain one or more lists of legislation and create status reports from these lists. See the "**Managing Your Subscription – Main**" section on page 14 to learn more about how to manage a list(s).

**Note**: To take advantage of the **Tracking** feature **you must complete a tracking subscription and then sign in**. See the **"Tracking Legislation – Sign Up"** section on page 11 for more details.

To view and listen to testimony about a current piece of legislation, on the Summary Tab next to the Committee(s): row, click the camera icon(s) on its legislation page.

To perform a Legislative Data Download, follow the steps enumerated below using Internet Explorer.

- On the GAM Home page, at the bottom of the What's Happening Now section, click the Open Legislative Data link.
- 2. This will display the **Open Legislative Data Download** dialog box.
- 3. Click the download button next to the current or a prior year.
- 4. This will display a Windows Internet Explorer dialog box.
- Select Open to automatically open the file within your default spreadsheet or database application, or the Save As option to save the file local to your hard drive. If you selected Save As, select the network or local folder to store the (BillMaster.csv) file in and then click Save.
- 6. This will return you to the **Open Legislative Data Download** dialog box.
- 7. Click **Close** to close this dialog box.

In addition, you will also find links to publications that summarize the <b>STATUS</b> of all legislation introduced in both chambers during the current Legislative Session.
	Some of the information will be available in <b>HTML</b> , as well as, <b>PDF</b> if format. Documents in HTML format can be sorted using specific column headers in either ascending or descending order.
	For the current Legislative Session, <b>Synopsis</b> reports for both chambers will display the <b>Legislation Tracking</b> <sup>4</sup> <b>Tack</b> in the last column of the report.
Budget	Here you will find matter dealing specifically with the State's <b>Operating</b> and <b>Capital</b> budgets. Quick links to <b>publication</b> is lists and the legislation page for versions in both chambers are provided.
Highlighted	Here you will find document links to publications about important topics that are most often asked about during the current Legislative Session.
Education Commission	Here you will find links to Commission schedules and reports posted by the Department of Legislative Services.
Highly Searched	A snap shot of the two most commonly searched for bills, legislation by broad subjects, and narrow subjects (taken over a running seven day average).

In the General Assembly	Here users can find <b>Proceedings</b> lists and their associated <b>On-demand</b> audio. <b>Agendas</b> and <b>Dates of Interest</b> are also available.
	<b>Note</b> : For Proceeding lists, the word <b>Journalized</b> will appear next to a Session number. This indicates that any votes taken during this session are available.
Committee Meetings	Links to the <b>Senate</b> and <b>House</b> Committee pages are found here, as well as, links to <b>live streams</b> and the <b>on-demand</b> section of the Video page.

**Note:** Live video feeds are available for both the Senate and House Standing Committees. In addition, live feeds for certain Subcommittees associated with the **House Appropriations Committee** and **Senate Budget and Taxation** can be found in the aforementioned section, or on the "**Committee Audio and Video**" page, shown here to the right.

To open a Live stream:

• Click the Live link next to appropriate Senate or House committee or Subcommittee name.

This will launch the default **Mediasite** <sup>™</sup> player where you can see and listen to live testimony.

**Note**: For a list of compatible devices, operating systems, and web browsers, see page 10.

Also note that the live video/audio feed is delayed by 30-40 seconds.

Users can also click on the **Senate**, **House**, or **Other Committees** text, which will redirect you to the Video page. From there you can open a live stream using the

Live Live button, next to a *Committee* or *Subcommittee* name, or view **On-Demand** content (see the next page) for the current or previous session(s) back to the 2011 Session.

At the bottom of this section, links to **Committee** and **Budget Hearing Schedules** are available. These will provide users with the date, time, location, and topic for meetings and hearings held by General Assembly of Maryland.

To begin using the Legislation Tracking System please read through the next three subsections carefully.

**Note**: Morning emails continue until all legislation from the previous session has been enacted, normally the end of May following session. In addition, you must register each session to use the tracking system.

#### TRACKING LEGISLATION – SIGN UP

**TRACKING LEGISLATION - MAIN** 

To begin tracking legislation first **Create a subscription** using your email address, or the email address where you would like the reports sent (this will be your default User ID), to sign-up follow the steps enumerated below.

- 1. Click the **Tracking** items of interest link or **Tracking Tack** 4 located on the **Utility Bar** *This will display the Legislation Tracking Main page.*
- 2. To create a new subscription, go to the bottom of the page and click the **Sign Up** button.






Figure 18 - Legislation Tracking - Management Page




Figure 26 - Example of House Proceedings Page

## Article - State Government

## [Previous][Next]

§10–501.

(a) It is essential to the maintenance of a democratic society that, except in special and appropriate circumstances:

- (1) public business be performed in an open and public manner; and
- (2) citizens be allowed to observe:
  - (i) the performance of public officials; and
  - (ii) the deliberations and decisions that the making of public policy involves.

(b) (1) The ability of the public, its representatives, and the media to attend, report on, and broadcast meetings of public bodies and to witness the phases of the deliberation, policy formation, and decision making of public bodies ensures the accountability of government to the citizens of the State.

(2) The conduct of public business in open meetings increases the faith of the public in government and enhances the effectiveness of the public in fulfilling its role in a democratic society.

(c) Except in special and appropriate circumstances when meetings of public bodies may be closed under this subtitle, it is the public policy of the State that the public be provided with adequate notice of the time and location of meetings of public bodies, which shall be held in places reasonably accessible to individuals who would like to attend these meetings.




Figure 48 - Department of Legislative Services Home Page
